With the passing of Sosa Sensei in 2002 he became Senior Instructor of the IAA. In June 2003, he formed the Mid America Aikido Federation. Bonifay Sensei holds a BS in Secondary Education (speech/Drama) from Texas A&I University and a MFA in Theater from Trinity University. He is a massage therapist and certified Rolfer, and brings his knowledge of anatomy and alignment into his Aikido. He is married to Elly Lindsay (actress/teacher) and has an 22 year old son David.
